The Chateaubriand Fellowship is a grant offered by the Embassy of France in the United States. Every year, it allows doctoral students in Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics & Biology-Health and Humanities & Social Sciences enrolled in American universities to conduct research in France for 4 to 9 months. Chateaubriand fellows receive a stipend, a round trip ticket to France and health insurance.

Every year, approximately 1,200 teaching assistantships are offered for American citizens and permanent residents to teach English in public schools across all regions of metropolitan France and in the overseas departments.
